## Morning Session Descriptions – Choose ONE that fits your *skill* level. 8:30-11:30

**SMART Board 101:** This session is designed for teachers who have little or no experience using a SMART Board. Learn the basics of using SMART Board software to integrate and enhance classroom curriculum. Participants will learn how to set up a SMART Board and how to use the basic features of SMART Notebook software to begin creating your own SMART Board lessons.

Intermediate SMART Board: This session is designed for teachers who feel fairly comfortable with the basics of using a SMART Board and Notebook software and are ready to learn some new tricks and tips. AirLiner users are also welcome as the focus of this session will be applicable to AirLiner as well. You will learn some of the features available in SMART Notebook software such as dual-page display, layering and grouping, using tables, adding graphics and hyperlinks, ink aware, and more.

Advanced SMART Board: This session is designed for teachers who feel very comfortable using the SMART Board and Notebook software. AirLiner users are also welcome as the focus of this session will be applicable to the AirLiner. You will learn advanced features of SMART Notebook software such as animations, screen capture tool pull tabs, how to utilize the SMART Video Player with United Streaming videos, locate additional free software that will enhance the use of the SMART Board/AirLiner and much more.

**Xtreme SMART Board:** Participants will work with advanced features of Notebook software and learn techniques for incorporating these features into engaging lessons. Participants will be shown a variety of Notebook activities and will be challenged to replicate them. This session is best for teachers who are very comfortable with creating their own SMART Notebook lessons.

Intro to SMART Response Clickers (formerly called Senteo): This session is designed for teachers who have little or no experience using SMART Response clickers. Want to learn how to utilize SMART Response clickers in your classroom to engage learners and get the feedback you need as a teacher? Then come to this session to see how easy it is with SMART Response. SMART Response software is integrated right in SMART Notebook (the same software used with SMART Boards.) You will learn the basics in this session. Bring a class list and a SMART Response receiver with two clickers with you.

**SMART Response Clickers at a Glance:** Want to get an introduction on how SMART Response clickers can be used in the classroom? Come to this session to get an overview of how they can be used to instantly track quiz results and lesson comprehension, to gain immediate insight into student learning, and to help increase overall retention and engagement. If you attend the morning SMART Response class, please pick a different breakout session.

**Top Online Resources for Your "SMART" Classroom**: This session will cover the very best resources on the web that will help you to further integrate the SMART Board into your everyday teaching and become connected with other educators. Find lessons and resources to save you time!

**Multiply Engagement with SMART's Math Tools**: (Best for secondary classrooms!) SMART Notebook offers several new dynamic math tools, such as a shape creator, graph builder and advanced equation editor that will make your lessons more visual, understandable and interactive. Come learn how to use these tools in your classroom! **SMART Math Tools are available for an extra cost. However there is a free 30 day trial that can be used to try out the tools.**
